Registration Information

Registration begins on May 16th and can be done at any program site or either Burnaby Neighbourhood House location.

Income Tax receipts will be issued at the time of registration.

Children will be placed on a waitlist for weeks that are full.

Children who are not registered for all 6 weeks are only permitted 1 Splashdown trip.

Refunds will only be issued if cancellations are received 2 full weeks in advance. A \$10 cancellation fee will be charged.
